Minutes of May 22, 2019

The meeting was called to order by President, Doris Kemner at 7:25 p.m.

Members present: President Doris Kemner, Steven Daniels, Joe Kinney, Ryan Pentterics, and Shirley Harris

Members absent: JD Lancaster, Dave Orłowski, and Jason Herington, Karie Dorston

Visitor present: Bryan Maves

A motion was made by Joe Kinney and seconded by Steve Daniels to approve the April 19, 2019 minutes with two corrections being made. The dates in the second paragraph of the minutes should both read 2018 rather than 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

President Kemner advised the group that Karie Dorston has resigned from the DDA, effective immediately.

President Kemner reviewed the Church Street Parking Lot improvement plan as well as the South Alley Project with the group.

The Board discussed the downtown flower pots. JD Lancaster purchased additional pots to replace a broken one from last year, as well as some new ones to be placed in front of additional storefronts. Comerica Bank and Atlas Distillery each wanted one. Maves Fashion Faves is moving across the street to the Ehnis Building. Bryan Maves would like two flower pots; one on the Tecumseh Road side of his store and one on the US 12 side of his store. Shirley Harris would like the dirt topped of in her flower pot. President Kemner will advise Matt Dorr.

Joe Kinney and Jason Herington are working on the Rockin' on the River Event for either July 13 or July 20. President Kemner is working on the Music on The Porch Event to be held in August.

By consensus the group agreed to hold future meetings beginning at 6:30 p.m.

Bryan Maves has some interest in seeing if we might be able to develop a monthly event in the downtown, such as Third Fridays or something similar. We will discuss this possibility further.

Steven Daniels made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. Shirley Harris seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
