May 2, 2016

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Members present were President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters, Doris Kemner and Greg Michalak.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Peters to approve the April 4, 2016 and April 25, 2016 council minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Sines to approve the checks written for the period ending April 30, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Kemner to approve the 2015 senior citizen utility rebates in the amount of \$1,957.41. Motion carried unanimously.

Council was supportive of the new DPW uniform logo.

Council discussed scheduling a meeting with the downtown merchants and the Michigan Economic Development Corporation to discuss revitalization of the downtown.

Council discussed the MDEQ's new lead and copper rules which each community will need to implement to aid in the protection of public health. The Village is in compliance with the current drinking water rules and is working with its engineers and the MDEQ to develop a plan to comply with the new rules.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to receive and file the council information packet. Motion carried unanimously.

There will be a special meeting on May 9, 2016 at 7:00 pm to award the Tate Park gazebo bid and discuss the MDOT required Limited English Proficiency Plan.

The Village Manager advised that nomination forms will be handed out at the June meeting and must be given to the Township Clerk by the end of July.

The following comments were from Council. Bonnie Peters reminded everyone to vote on Tuesday and that the farmers market will open May 20th.

President Mowery said the American Legion was very pleased with how well the Veteran's Memorial Park was being maintained by the DPW.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Michalak to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
