The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm

Members present were President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters, Doris Kemner and Greg Michalak.

Council discussed the Tate Park gazebo bids which came in under budget. The Village will use the Tate Park Trust Funds to pay for the new gazebo.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Habrick to award the construction bid for the Tate Park gazebo to Green Meadows in the amount of \$48,111.20. Motion carried unanimously.

Council discussed the first draft of Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan from the Michigan Department of Transportation. The plan requires the communities to not discriminate based on race, color, national origin, sex, socioeconomic status or geographical location. It also calls for communities to provide an interpreter, written translation in languages other than English and translation of documents.

The Village Manager up dated Council on the Clinton Arts Center construction project.

The following comments were from Council. Greg Michalak asked when the chip sealing of streets would start and how affected residents would be notified.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Kemner to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
