Special Council Meeting
November 7, 2017

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Member present were President Kemner, Carl Habrick, Greg Michalak, Merlin Mowery and Bonnie Peters. Larry Sines and Joe Orban were absent.

Bonnie Peters joined the meeting at 7:04 pm.

Ms. Pam Blough, PM Blough Inc, joined the meeting through a conference call to lead Council in discussion on Place Making information that was gathered at previous meetings. The four topics of discussion were (1) Access/ linkages: Connecting the downtown, schools, Tate Park and Tecumseh with sidewalks, lighting and bike trails. (2) Uses/Activities: Access to the river for kayaking and canoeing, new trails in the park, food trucks for special events, access from west side of Tate Park, and evening activities in the park. (3) Comfort/Image: More diverse housing, replace welcome signs, seasonal banners, pedestrian friendly downtown, public restroom and wi-fi available. (4) Sociability: Improve store fronts, more opportunities for shade, color of street light polls, adding retail and food and beverage businesses, improve rear entrances of businesses, signage for parking/historical areas.

Council discussed meeting dates to prioritize item for Place Making.

Council discussed Christmas lighting for the downtown.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Michalak to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 9:23 pm.
