November 19, 2018

The meeting opened at 7:10 pm

Member present were President Doris Kemner, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Bonnie Peters, Greg Michalak, Kevin Kelly. Joe Orban was absent.

Bonnie Peters, Greg Michalak and Kevin Kelly were sworn in.

Council discussed the recreational marijuana ordinance.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to adopt Ordinance number 2018-04. An ordinance to prohibit marijuana establishments pursuant to the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana Act, ballot proposal 1 of 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

The Village Manager updated Council on his meeting with the MDEQ regarding the Village's concerns with the new Lead and Copper Rules.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Sines to go into closed session pursuant to Section 8 (d) of the Open Meetings Act, to discuss the purchase of property for the DDA. Motion carried unanimously with a roll call vote. Closed session started at 7:55 pm.

The Village Manager reported on the Republic Recycling issues and a candidate for the wastewater treatment plant supervisor position.
