

Village of Clinton
Council Minutes
September 16, 2019

The meeting called to order at 7:00 pm.

Members Present were President Doris Kemner, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Bonnie Peters, Greg Michalak and Kevin Kelly. Joe Orban was absent.

Several residents were in attendance to ask questions about the Village possibly using the Oak Openings Building for the Village Office and the Smith Kimball Community Center. The Village will discuss the concept with the Clinton Arts Center, Community Center and school.

The Village was not able to finalize construction details for the south Sunset Drive storm water improvements so they worked through the details for the north site. The Village was able to finalize construction details for the Sunset Drive storm water improvement project located from 313 to 319 Sunset Drive. The excavation is scheduled to start September 25, 2019.

The Village DPW is no longer able to keep up with the work load of the DPW and Water Department, especially in light of the new state drinking water requirements and water treatment plant. Staff will work to bring a recommendation back to Council for further consideration.

The Police department continues to struggle to find part-time police officers to fill open positions.

The Village Manager gave an update on the bench recommended for the South Alley Parking Lot Project, the separation agreement for MSCPA General Manager, and the projected final cost for the South Alley Parking Lot Project.

The Village Clerk advised the new Welcome sign for north bound Tecumseh Road is scheduled to be installed soon.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 9:05 pm.
