June 3, 2013

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Motion was made by Peters and seconded by Kemner to approve the May 6, 2013 council meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Orban and seconded by Sines to approve the checks written for the period ending May 31, 2013. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to approve the 2012 Senior Citizen Rebates in the amount of \$3,836.60. Motion carried unanimously.

The most recent water quality test results for Well 5 came in very good with iron levels of non-detect and the hardness significantly softer than well 1.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Davis to approve I.T. Right for the computer IT needs in the amount of \$3,500 annually and \$500.00 per year for remote back up services. Motion carried unanimously.

Council was updated on the Jackson Street gas main replacement.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Kemner to approve OMM Engineering, Inc. to prepare the design and bid documents for the proposed soccer field improvements. Motion carried with Habrick abstaining because of a conflict of interest.

Senator Bruce Caswell addressed Council on the personal property tax and state budget.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Kemner to approve banners for the downtown. Motion carried unanimously.

Council was supportive of having Carlisle Wortman and Associates assist in the review of the draft amendments to the sign ordinance.

Motion was made by Peters and seconded by Sines to approve and file the Council information packet. Motion carried unanimously.

The Village Manager reported DTE Energy donated \$1,000 to the Veteran's Memorial Park Improvement Project; there are some businesses interested in the facade grant; and updated status of the WWTP head works building ground water problem.

The following comments were from Council. Dianne Davis asked about the status of the Village's police car computers. Carl Habrick asked for an update on the sale of the Pilkington building. Bonnie Peters asked about the grant application for the Veteran's

Memorial Park Improvements. Doris Kemner asked if the bushes by the sign at Tate Park could be trimmed, and asked for Council's help at the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Clinton Fall Festival.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded Peters to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45pm.
