September 9, 2013

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Members present were President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Dianne Davis, Larry Sines, Bonnie Peters, and Doris Kemner.

Motion by Sines and seconded by Peters to approve the August 5, 2013 council minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Ruth Knoll from Clinton Rotary presented Council with a list that was discussed at Rotary on what Clinton needs.

Joe Orban joined the meeting at 7:05 pm.

Motion by Peters and seconded by Davis to approve the checks written for the period ending August 30, 2013. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Habrick and seconded by Kemner to issue the Notice of Award to Slusarski Excavation in the amount of \$69,894.00 for the soccer field improvements. Motion carried unanimously.

The well five water continues to come in with low levels of iron and slightly lower levels of hardness.

The Farmers Market grant of \$35,000 was approved for the first year of the market. The grant will be used to hire a part time manager who will develop and manage the farmers market. Council thanked the Andrah Foundation for the grant.

Council discussed the first draft of the Community Events Calendar Policy. The document will be amended based on Council direction and presented at the October meeting.

Council was updated on recent events affecting the Medical Marijuana law.

Council was updated on the website conversion process. After several delays the new website is starting to come together.

Council was updated on one of the Veterans Memorial Park Grant requests that was denied.

Motion by Habrick and seconded by Peters to receive and file the council information packet. Motion carried unanimously.

The Village Manager updated Council on the Woolen Mill case and cancelling the 2013 chip seal work.

The following comments were from Council. Carl Habrick reminded Council of the Rib & Blues Festival that will be held on September 13th and 14th from 5 pm to 11 pm. Bonnie Peters gave an update on the Christmas parade that will be held on December 7th at 7:00 pm. Doris Kemner asked for volunteers to help at the Fall Festival hospitality booth; asked for the grass at the water tower and west side of Tate Park be mowed for Fall Festival; asked about a new street light by the Woolen Mill; and would like some string lights put up on the park bridge for the Fall Festival.

Motion by Habrick and seconded by Davis to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
