The meeting opened at 7:00pm.

Members present were President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Dianne Davis, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters, and Doris Kemner.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Peters to approve the September 5, 2012 council minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Carolyn Bates introduced herself to council. She is running for the Lenawee County Register of Deeds on the November ballot. Todd Morgan introduced himself and is running for Lenawee County Board of Commissioner Seat for District 9.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Habrick to approve the checks written for the period ending September 30, 2012. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Davis to adopt Ordinance Number 3 of 2012. An ordinance to amend the zoning of 810 Tecumseh Road from Highway Service Commercial to Medium Density Residential District. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Peters and seconded by Sines to approve the conditional use permit to have a church at 810 Tecumseh Road. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Davis to approve the Michigan Municipal League Liability & Property Pool ballot as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Council was updated on the 25 percent renewables by 2025 ballot proposal.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Habrick to award the 114 Jackson Street demolition bid to Brady Sand and Gravel at a cost of \$39,471.00. Motion carried with Sines voting no.

Council was updated on the new salt spreader that was ordered.

Council will have a special meeting on October 22, 2012 to award the bid for the Well 5 project.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Davis to receive and file the council information packet. Motion carried unanimously.

The Village Manager reported on the backup system for the Village file server.

The following comments were from Council. Dianne Davis congratulated the Fall Festival for a great weekend. Larry Sines commented on the good turnout for the

festival. Bonnie Peters was pleased to hear vendors were already signing up for next year. Doris Kemner thanked everyone who helped with the Fall Festival especially Village employees. President Mowery also commented on how nice Tate Park looked.

Motion was made by Davis and seconded by Habrick to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
