

Village of Clinton  
May 16, 2011

The meeting opened at 7:00pm.

Members present were President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Dianne Davis, Larry Sines, Joe Urban, Doris Kemner, and Bonnie Peters.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Habrick to allow the Fall Festival to have the Fall Festival Reunion Days which included a food, beverage and entertainment tent. Motion failed with Davis, Urban, Sines, and President Mowery voting no.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Sines to adopt Resolution Number 2011-07. A resolution approving power sales contract and supplement for participation in 1.4 Mw of the American Municipal Power Fremont Energy Center combined-cycle natural gas power plant. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Peters to authorize the 2010 senior citizen utility rebates in the amount of \$3,979.61. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Davis and seconded by Kemner to authorize payment of \$2,000 to the Lenawee Economic Development Corporation for 2011 membership. Motion carried unanimously.

Council was asked to walk through Tate Park to see if the placement of locations for the new ADA benches and tables are appropriate. Council will give direction at the June meeting.

The following comments were from Council. Carl Habrick reported the Ford dealership and Frontier properties need to be mowed, advised there was no compost at the site, and asked for an update about broken play equipment at Tate Park. Doris Kemner would like three picnic tables by the play area, three more baby swings and four more swings for ages six to ten out at Tate Park; asked if the sprinklers downtown are working and would like to have hanging baskets and flowers around the downtown trees; and asked if the Village could maintain and weed the Tate park entrance.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Kemner to approve \$200.00 from the DDA to purchase flowers for the downtown and if a committee comes forward that would like to purchase and plant the flowers. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45pm.
