V. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

I hereby certify the electrical work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself in my own home in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the State Electrical Code and shall not be covered up, or put into operation until is has been inspected and approved by the Electrical Inspector. I will cooperate with the Electrical Inspector and assume the responsibility for the necessary corrections and inspections.

Section 23a of the State Construction Act of 1972, of Public Acts of 1972, being Section 125.125a of the Michigan Compiled

Section 23a of the State Construction Code for 1972, of the Public Acts of 1972, being Section 1251.23a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, prohibits a person from commencing or performing the licensing requirements of this State relating to persons who are to perform work on a building or a residential structure. Violators of Section 23a are subject to civil fines.

VI. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Plans and specifications for new construction work, alteration, repair, expansion, or modification shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act 299 of the Public Acts of 1980 as amended, and shall bear the architect's or engineer's signature and seal.

A PLAN REVIEW IS REQUIRED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

Exception 1: Alteration and repairs determined by the electrical official to be of a minor nature
 Exception 2: Work completed by a Governmental Subdivision or State Agency costing less than \$15,000
 Exception 3: A building of use group R-3 or R-4 containing no more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
 Exception 4: Wiring or alteration to an electrical system that is greater than 400 Amperes, unless requested by administrative authority

VI. EXPIRED PERMIT AND GENERAL STATEMENT

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for a permit has been filed with the Mechanical Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months (6) after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months (6) after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. A \$30.00 FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR CANCELING PERMITS. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED. AN EXPIRED PERMIT MAY BE RE-ISSUED AT 1/2 THE ORIGINAL PERMIT FEE IF THE AMOUNT IS LESS THAN \$100.00. IF THE PERMIT FEE IS GREATER THAN \$100.00 THEN A FEE OF \$50.00 OR 10% OF THE ORIGINAL PERMIT FEE WHICH EVER IS GREATER SHALL BE PAID PRIOR TO CONTINUING ANY WORK.

Electrical Inspections Required

New Homes - 3 Inspections - Service, Rough, Final. Additions - 2 Inspection - Rough, Final unless service is moved. Pools Inground - 3 Inspections - Trench, grounding/Bonding, Final Pools Above Ground - 2 Inspections - Trench/grounding/bonding, Final Generator Manual Transfer Switch - 1 Inspection, Final. Temporary Service - 1 Inspection - Final. Service upgrade - 1 Inspection - Final when circuits are tied into panel.

Any inspection needed beyond the number allowed will be charged at a rate of \$35.00 per inspection and must be paid prior to re-inspection.
