March 2, 2015

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Members present were President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters, Doris Kemner and Tim Waters.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Waters to approve the February 2, 2015 council minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Shane Preston, Legislative Director for Senator Dale Zorn, gave a legislative update and answered Council questions.

Motion was made by Peters and seconded by Kemner to approve the checks written for the period ending February 28, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Council member Carl Habrick removed himself from Council due to conflict of interest on the discussion of purchasing the Clinton Local.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Orban to adopt Resolution Number 2015-02. A resolution authorizing the loaning of funds from the Robison Trust to the Downtown Development Authority (DDA) fund for purchasing 108 Tecumseh Road. Motion carried unanimously.

Council member Carl Habrick rejoined Council.

Council discussed the preliminary 2015-16 budget.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Peters to adopt Resolution Number 2015-03. A resolution to amend the 2014-15 fiscal year budget. Motion carried unanimously.

Council discussed the renewal agreement for refuse collection with Republic Services.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Waters to receive and file the council information packet. Motion carried unanimously.

The following comments were from council. Bonnie Peters advised that St. Dominic's approved the use of the Hall for the Christmas parade, and asked about the formation of a Chamber of Commerce? Doris Kemner said a lot of people are participating in the Clinton Arts Center classes. Carl Habrick stated that March is reading month at the Elementary School and anyone interested in reading to a class should call the elementary school for more information.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
