October 19, 2015

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Members present were, President Mowery, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters and Doris Kemner. Absent were Carl Habrick and Tim Waters.

The public hearing opened at 7:02 pm. The purpose of the hearing was to receive comments on the proposed water and sewer rate increases. The proposed sewer rate increase is \$3.25 per month for the average residential customers. The proposed water rate increase is \$1.60 per month for the average residential customer. Commercial and industrial customers will pay proportionately more based on their meter size.

Mr. Glen Burkhardt, Engineered Logic LLC addressed Council on the proposed increases. The following comments were from the public. Mr. Richard Faust asked what is the proposed service charge for a 2 inch water meter; how did it come about that we are using less water; and what do you tell the people who are cutting back already and will still have a higher bill? The public hearing closed at 7:48 pm.

Motion was made by Orban and seconded by Sines to adopt Resolution Number 2015-11. The resolution to amend the water and sewer rates and charges will be effective on the January billing. Motion carried unanimously.

The Village Manager gave an update on the Clinton Art Center.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Peter to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
