Council Minutes
September 4, 2019

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Members Present were President Doris Kemner, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters, Greg Michalak and Kevin Kelly.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Peters to approve the August 5, 2019 regular minutes, and the August 5, 2019 closed minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

No citizen input or suggestions.

The public hearing on the Electric Cost of Service Study opened at 7:04 pm, and closed at 7:10 pm.

Motion was made by Michalak and seconded by Orban to approve Resolution Number 2019-08, a resolution to increase the electric rates to cover the cost of service. Motion carried unanimously.

Presentation of the 2018-19 Audit was given by John Nowinski of the Lally Group LLC.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Habrick to approve the checks written for period ending August 31, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

The Michigan liquor license application for John DeAngelis was discussed. Council was in support of the Class C license, and recommended denial of the dance/entertainment permit. President Kemner will provide a letter of concern to the Liquor Control Commission.

Motion was made by Orban and seconded by Sines to approve the Class C portion of the liquor license application for Mr. John DeAngelis. Motion carried unanimously.

Council was updated on electric energy and capacity.

The Village Manager updated council on the Lead & Copper Rule litigation.

Council discussed the Sunset electric ROW and drainage project.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to receive and file the Council information packet. Motion carried unanimously.

The Village Manager reported that a park employee was bitten by a dog and that a citation was issued. He also provided an update on the South Alley Construction Project.

Council Member Peters commented on how nice the south alley is looking. Council Member Orban asked about the size of the cutout on Coman Street for the watermain repair.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to go into closed session pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, to discuss the purchase of property. Motion carried unanimously with a roll call vote. Closed session started at 8:55 pm.

Motion was made by Orban and seconded by Habrick to go into open session. Motion carried unanimously. Open session started at 9:50 pm.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Peters to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
