The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Members present were President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Dianne Davis, Larry Sines, Doris Kemner, and Bonnie Peters.

Joe Orban joined the meeting at 7:04pm.

President Mowery, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, and Joe Orban were sworn in by the Village Clerk.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Davis to approve the November 5, 2012 council minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Peters to approve the checks written for the period ending November 30, 2012. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Peters and seconded by Orban to adopt Resolution Number 2012-10. A resolution to amend the water and sewer rates and charges. Motion carried unanimously.

Council was updated on the proposed legislation to eliminate personal property taxes.

Motion was made by Sines and seconded by Orban to adopt Resolution Number 2012-11. A resolution pursuant to the publicly funded Health Insurance Contribution Act, Public Act 152 of 2011. Motion carried unanimously.

Council discussed the Electric Energy Optimization Program. Instead of distributing CFL light bulbs this year the Village will make energy efficiency improvements to Village buildings.

The Christmas parade will be December 8, 2012 at 5:00 pm.

Council discussed liability insurance for special events.

Council was updated on the draft sign ordinance amendments.

Council was updated on the Clean Diesel Grant application for a new snow plow truck.

Motion was made by Kemner and seconded by Habrick to receive and file the council information packet. Motion carried unanimously.

The Village Manger reported on the River Raisin Water Shed Council and the equestrian state championship sign request.

The following comments were from Council. Dianne Davis stated that the Christmas decorations downtown look nice and the new preschool building looks amazing. Larry Sines asked about the Lenawee County Drain Commission assessment for two drains in the Village. Bonnie Peters asked when the well five water main construction will start. Doris Kemner asked about the plans for the soccer field improvements and when will the work start; she asked if there was anything happening with LEDC; and she had some people ask about the chlorine taste in the water.

Motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Davis to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
